3. Scan/photograph your finished illustration Make sure to scan at (at least)300 dpi/ppi.

4. Create a PDF of your work to turn in to the instructor computer (Use InDesign or Preview to make a PDF)

5. PDF must be titled Lastname_Firstname_IllustraredPoem_Project.pdf


