Sharp serrated edges & Feet

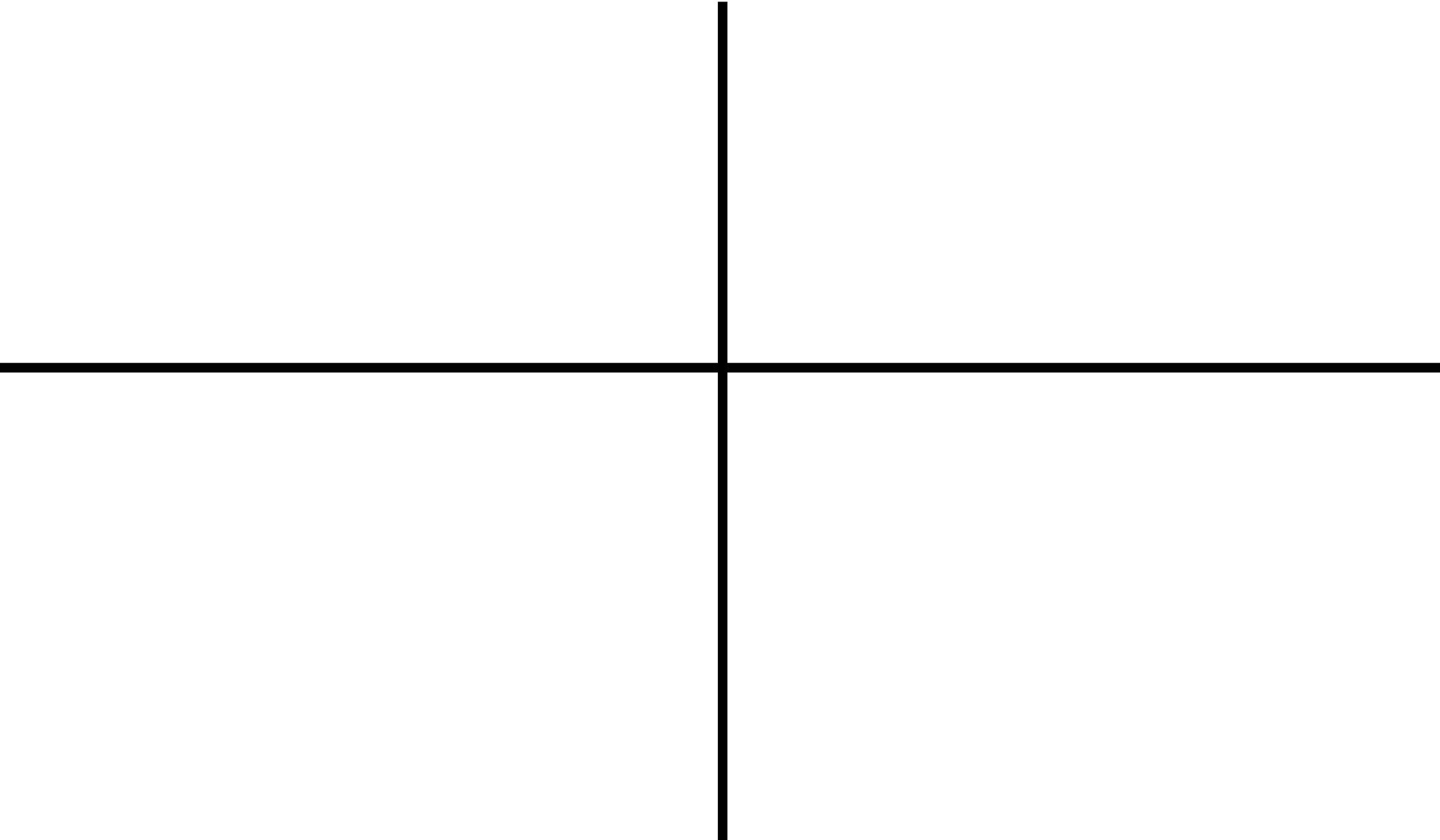
Find four letters in this kind of font. Put one in each box. Type the name of the font you used.
