

## Project #3: "Web Portfolio" (20 points)

### Design Brief

Design a website to showcase your web design portfolio (feel free to use this website as a showcase for projects from other classes, as well, such as graphic design, fine art, photography, music, etc.)

This website should replace your current `index.html` file in your root directory, and it *must* include:

**Professional practice standards** (functional directory folder structure, no broken links, bandwidth-appropriate file sizes)

**Your personal ASCII logo/brand** hidden in `<!-- comment tags -->` in the `<head>` on all pages

### HTML5 Semantic

**Tags** (i.e. `<header>`, `<h1>`, `<h2>`, `<nav>`, `<ul>`, `<main>`, `<section>`, `<article>`, `<figure>`, `<figcaption>`, `<footer>`, etc.)

**Flexible elements** (dimensions specified in percentage `%` units or viewport width `vw` and viewport height `vh` units)

**Interactive components** (pseudo-class `:hover`)

**CSS3 `@font-face` Rule** embedded fonts (at least two)

**CSS3 `@media` Rule** media query breakpoints (at least two)

**CSS3 `transform` Property** (at least one)

**CSS3 `transition` Property** (at least one)

**CSS3 `@keyframes` Rule** animation (at least one)

**jQuery Library** (at least one; either a snippet of jQuery code you've written yourself, or an open-source library, such as Fancybox)

A logo for your design "studio"

Page anchor links for *all* class projects, demos, and

exercises. Each project link should have an image and a statement of what the project is about.

An "About" yourself page or section, with a biographical statement and a brand graphic or profile picture

A "Links" page with at least five (5) links to inspirational and reference websites

Your final project website must be uploaded at the beginning of your scheduled final exam. Late submissions will *not* be accepted.
